### Tay Township Municipal Office reopening to the public, effective June 14, 2021

**Tay, Ontario** – With the recent lifting of the Provincial Stay-at-home order and in accordance with the Provincial Reopening Plan, Tay Township will be reopening the Municipal Office effective Monday June 14, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.

In alignment with Step 1 of the Provincial Roadmap to Reopening, services continue to be available online, or by appointment.

- **Tax and water bill payments can be made through your bank either online or at a bank branch.** Payments can also be made in the drop box located outside the municipal office.
- Late payment fees and interest on all bills issued after January 1, 2021 will be waived for all current water/wastewater and tax accounts, until July 31, 2021. Late fees and interest will apply starting August 1, 2021.

- Online Day Camp registration will open June 16, 2021 at 8:30am. Register online at [tay.ca/register](http://tay.ca/register)
- All Park Washrooms and portable toilets will be open as of Friday June 11, 2021.
