Review of Comments:

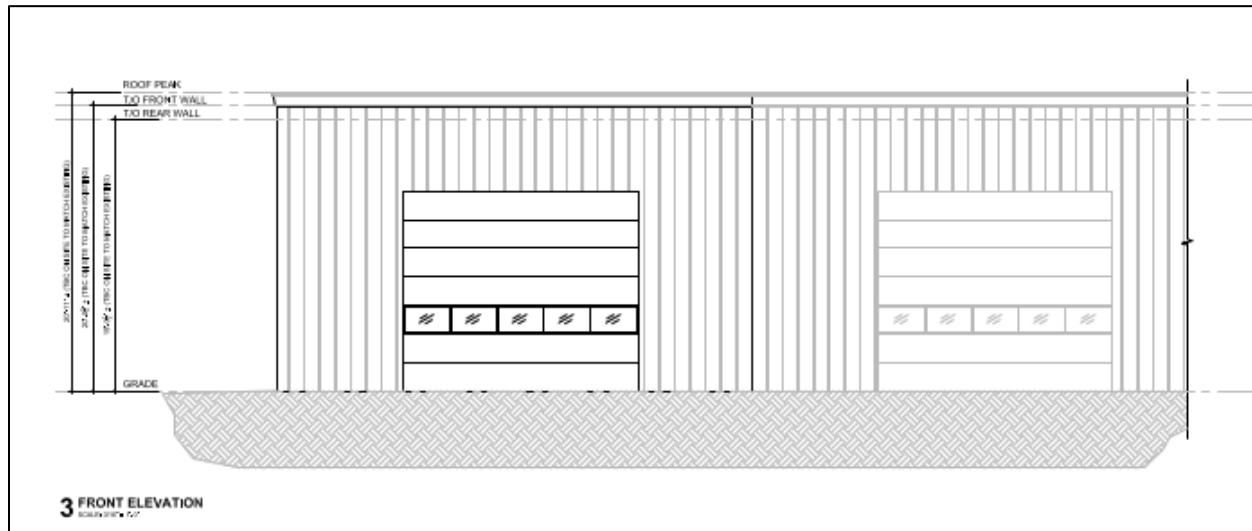
